

AIRPORT CONSTRUCTION FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

OVERVIEW

The development of Cape Winelands International Airport represents a significant investment in regional infrastructure and economic growth. The construction will create substantial employment opportunities for local communities.

Below is a list of frequently asked questions as received to date:

When will construction start?

The first phase of construction is anticipated to begin in the last quarter of the year. This initial phase, referred to as enablement works, will include site preparation and foundational activities.

What types of jobs will be available?

- Skilled labour: engineers, electricians, plumbers, and other technical specialists.
- Semi-skilled labour: workers with technical knowledge to support construction tasks.
- Unskilled labour: general site support, including site cleaning, material handling, and manual assistance.

How can we apply for jobs?

WBHO, the main contractor, will establish registration centres where interested candidates can register. These will be located in Fistantekraal and Klipheuwel. Your information will be securely added to the WBHO database to facilitate job allocation as positions become available.

When will the Community Roadshow take place?

We anticipate that the Community Roadshow will take place in May this year.

When will the Registration Centres be open and for how long?

We anticipate that the registration centres will open in June 2026. The registration centres will be open for approximately 2 months. We will work with the ward councillors and community forums to ensure that awareness is raised once the registration centres are open.

Can I email you my CV?

No, we propose that you wait for the registration centers to be open to ensure that your details are listed on the correct database.

Will the contractor use a labour broker?

No, the contractor will not use labour brokers. All recruitment will be managed directly through the WBHO registration centres, ensuring a fair and transparent process for all applicants.

What recruitment activity will take place at the airport?

None. There will be no recruitment at the airport.
